## OJAI FOOD PROJECT

Dear Congregation,

The generosity of the donations from our congregation has been such a blessing to support our food ministries. The following is a summary of what is happening to help our community:

On the third Tuesday of each month, we prepare approximately 20 sandwiches which we take to Help of Ojai for distribution. The money for this comes from your donations during special plate offerings.

# Sandwich distribution will be on January 15th and February 19th.

On the second Monday of the month, our church participates in the Winter Shelter Dinner Program.

This program is held at St. Andrews Episcopal Church in Ojai. Volunteers from our church are asked to arrive at 5:45pm. We usually feed between 25 to 35 clients. The monthly cost for this program is between \$125 to \$135. This program will run through March 2019. Sign up sheets are passed around each month requesting volunteers.

# Winter Shelter Dinners will be served on January 14th and February 11th.

The food drive is an ongoing ministry. So feel free to bring any of the items listed to the church for drop off.



### **Trustee's Report**

Happy New Year to you all! 2018 was a busy year for our church, and 2019 promises to be busy as well. We would like to thank everyone for the contributions that have been made to maintain and improve both our church and parsonage.

Below is a list of some of the projects completed over the past two months (and some upcoming projects):

- \* A third television was hung in the Sanctuary to assist Pastor Rachel and Chris with viewing what is being shown on the monitors seen by the congregation. The television was graciously donated to the church.
- \* Costs have been finalized to remodel the guest bathroom in the parsonage. The Church Council approved the remodel costs so that we could go forward and sign a contract with a contractor. (the same one that did the work on the smaller bathroom). The remodel will begin on, or near, January 17th.
- \* We have been meeting with a technology consultant to help us determine our options regarding possible change of our telephone and internet service to a new company, or remain with our current provider. The issue is that our internet speed is extremely slow, and access is almost impossible in various areas due to the lathe and plaster walls. Additional telephone lines are needed to serve and support our office personnel, our congregation and the community services we support. We are discussing the change with Spectrum, and our current provider, AT&T. More information will be provided as we proceed through this process.
- \* Going forward into this new year, we will begin work on the Fireside Room. Monies for this project have come from donations. This project is estimated to begin approximately March 1st. We will begin contemplating our options in February, and if anyone has any suggestions, please feel free to let us know. We will have some cardboard color swatches on the walls for you to view. All involved want this room to be welcoming and comfortable (and timeless in décor).
- \* The next major project that needs our attention is the termite situation in the Sanctuary. Work has already been done on the exterior front windows frames by replacing, or fixing ,and painting them. The interior windows were also repaired where needed and the paneling at the bottom of the windows was replaced. The next step is to fumigate the entire church by tenting the entire structure, plus drill and treat the subterranean termites on the south wall of the Sanctuary. The cost of this work to still be done is \$8.250.00. There is currently \$3,213.00 in our "termite fund". We will need to raise another \$5,037.00 through gifts and donations over the next two months. We hope all will find a way to give a little extra money towards this important work so that this project can be completed. This type of project is not as exciting as seeing the Fireside Room refurbishment, but it is every bit as important.


