SAFE WORSHIP RESTRICTIONS

The following are necessary if we are going to be able to worship at the drive-in and welcome all comers.

1. If you are sick, stay home.
2. You must come in a car or other enclosed vehicle. No pedestrians, bicycles, motorcycles, horses, or open convertibles.
3. Park carefully according to the usher's instructions.
4. Worshippers must stay in their cars at all times. This is extremely important. Thank you for your full cooperation!
5. If you need to roll down a car window, only roll down on the driver's side of the car. This is to maintain a safe distance between each household. If your window is down, please wear a mask.
6. Do not share food or drink between cars. We will not be serving coffee and treats, but feel free to bring your own!
7. Please safely make your way out of the parking lot when the service is finished and avoid the temptation to get out of your car and visit with others.
