## What's the Big Idea?

Celebrate! We're all invited to God's party.

Fun Facts About Jewish Weddings...

A Jewish couple is married under a canopy called a *huppah*, pronounced, "hoop-uh."

Young adults in Jesus' time were married off to help their families, not [usually] for love.

A Jewish marriage contract is called a ketubah, pronounced, "keh-too-buh."

> Weddings, like the one in the parable about The Wedding Banquet, were events that lasted for several days.

At Jewish weddings, the groom stomps on a glass to remember the destruction of the temple (see 2 Kings 25:8-17).

> A parable is a fictitious story that helps explain a lesson. Why is this story a parable?

## Talk About It

Enjoy time of curiosity and conversation with a trusted grown up:

- 1. What kind of clothing do people usually wear to a wedding?
- 2. What might a couple getting married think if someone didn't dress up for their special event?
- 3. Name some people you've invited to your home as a guest. Name a few people who have invited you to their home as a guest. What makes someone a good host? A good guest?
- 4. Invite an adult family member to find a few pictures from their wedding. Talk about what happened on that day. Are the people in the picture happy? Why or why not.
