- 1) Whom do you know that follows Jesus today?
- 2) What other amazing things do you know about Jesus?
- 3) What other stories about the disciples do you know?
- 4) What do you think it means to, "fish for people?"
- 5) Shuffle a deck of cards. Take turns drawing one without looking. Every time you draw an odd number, talk about a difficult thing you've had to learn to do. If you draw an even number, share how you are a disciple. If you draw a face card, sing a silly song or tell a silly joke.


