#### Lenten packet drive-thru pickup

You are invited to drive through Trinity's 4th St. small parking lot on Feb. 17 to receive ashes and pick up your Lenten packet. Three times throughout the day: between 8–9 a.m., noon – 1 p.m. or 5–6 p.m. If you desire to receive ashes from a pastor, you must wear a mask. Pick up a Lenten packet which will include ashes for your use at home (if you prefer imposing ashes yourself), Lenten stickers, calendar and blessing.
