


Sunday, February 14, 2021 The Transfiguration Mark 9:2-9





God's glory is forever — in the past, present, and future!

The story of the Transfiguration brings together important figures from both the Old and New Testaments in an unbelievable way. Along with Jesus and three of his disciples are Moses, one called by God to lead the Hebrew people out of slavery, and the prophet Elijah, who was expected to return to Earth before the coming of the Messiah.

What does "transfiguration" mean?

Trans has several meanings, but one of them is to change or have changed from one thing to another.

Take the word, transaction for example. Money changes hands from the buyer to the seller.

Figure means a form or a shape.

When you put the two together, you get a word that means a figure that has changed shape or form.


