What's the Big Idea?

We know Jesus is the Messiah!

The word *Messiah* literally means "anointed one." In the Bible, kings were anointed (being anointed means to be chosen as someone very special) by having oil poured over their head. Calling Jesus *Messiah* meant Jesus was a very special chosen one!

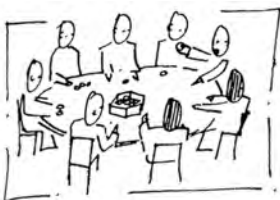
Where do you see Squiggles this week?

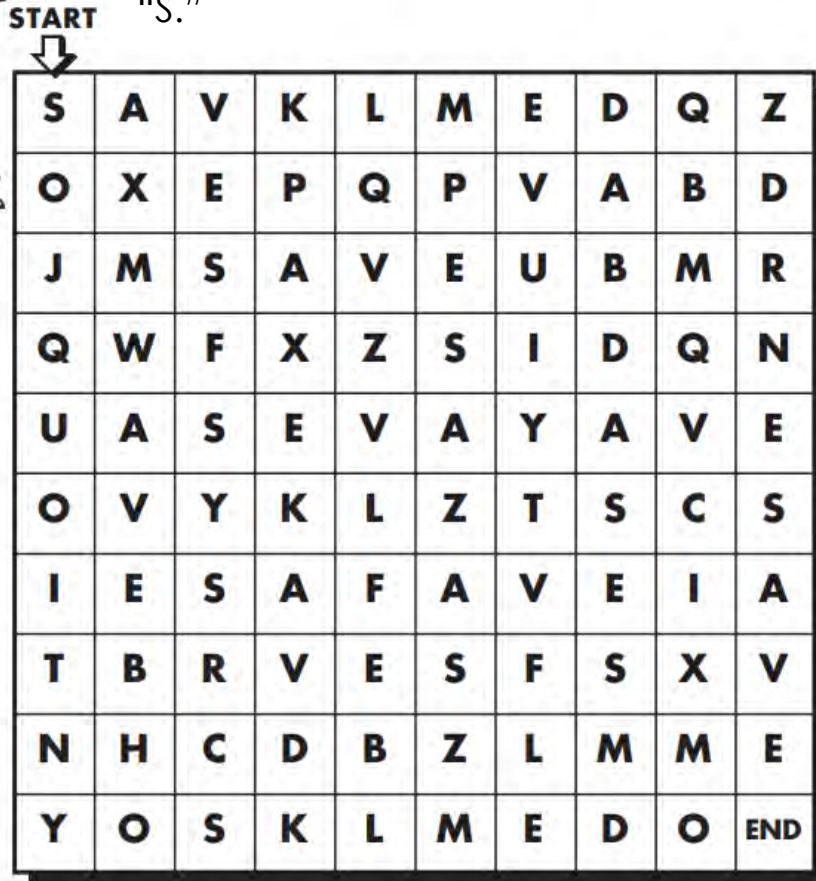
