Live It Together

Talk About It

- 1) A shepherd takes care of sheep. What does our family help take care of?
- 2) How do we know Jesus cares for us?
- 3) How does God help us when we're having a hard time?
- 4) Open a small bag of multi-colored candies. Assign a candy-color to each person. Take turns picking out a candy. Whoever has their color drawn thanks God for taking care of someone in their life and then gets to eat the candy!
