## Spread the news about God's love and Jesus!

Jesus' disciples were frustrated that someone who was not a disciple was teaching people about Jesus. But Jesus explained to his confused disciples that, "It is important to help people who believe in me, no matter who they are. It is not a good thing to stop someone from believing in me. All of God's children can help each other have faith. Be at peace with other people!" This lesson of sharing the news about God's love and Jesus is so important, that it shows up in other Gospels, too! You can find this same story not only in Mark, but in Matthew and Luke, too.

## Memorize It


Challenge yourself to memorize the following verse of the week.
