Jesus, the disciples, and Mary were invited to a wedding in a place called, Cana. Have you ever been to a wedding? How long did the wedding last?

What did you do at the wedding? In Jesus' time, a wedding did not last for a few hours. A wedding lasted for several days. Imagine that!
