## Doing What the Disciples DIDN'T

At the end of the Last Supper, Jesus took his disciples with him to an olive grove called the Garden of Gethsemane. There he asked them to “watch and pray” with him as he prepared himself for the agony of the coming hours as he would be arrested, beaten, mocked, scorned, tried, found guilty, condemned, beaten again, paraded through the streets, and nailed to a cross.

In the Garden, he got the disciples situated and then went off by himself to pray.

Three times he returned to his companions, and three times found them sleeping.

In his hours of deepest need, Jesus' closest friends failed him.

Every year on Maundy Thursday, we have the opportunity to do what the disciples DIDN'T: stay awake and “watch and pray” with Jesus in an all-night Prayer Vigil.



Every year we have a sign-up sheet and ask everyone to volunteer to take 30 minutes or an hour to pray, and for most years in the past, we had gaps in the prayers – usually sometime between midnight and 6am.

But this year, we had at least one person praying in every shift all night, and four people praying in most of them.

Thank you! Thank you (SEE THE FOLLOWING LIST), for doing for Jesus what his disciples didn't.

Our prayers changed the world for whatever and whomever we prayed in those times.

If you didn't take a shift this year, please take one next year. Jesus and the world need you and your prayers.

**Children of the Messiah Preschool:** The financial report was emailed separately. Paul Garcia, the chair of our diocesan Association of Episcopal Schools will be with us for Preschool Sunday at the 11am service on April 8.

**Children's Ministry:** Children's Minister Angela Lopez reports: I have been aggressively working on VBS. The menu is ready, 95% of volunteers are in place, and we have a few early registrations. Next week I will work on decorations, as well as stocking the tribe leaders travel baskets. We have an interesting problem: a "Church of the Messiah" in Ohio is getting registration for VBS from what they believe are our families. I have not publicized our unique log in anywhere other than my personal Facebook. However, when you Google "Church of the Messiah VBS," the first listing is for VBS registration for June 25-29 2019--But for the Westerville Ohio church. I am posting signs this week around church with our specific info. I usually wait until Easter but, if our families are so excited for VBS, they are googling to register early, I want them to have the correct info. People are calling after looking for VBS info on our website, but the website is broken, and I cannot post VBS details. I'm excited about the website rebuild, because that's what attracts the young families I serve.

Last week I submitted for publication in the May edition of the Central Florida Episcopalian our VBS invite and information. As soon as it is open, I will be submitting it to Z88.3 as well. I will be sending out invites the Tuesday after Easter to all the visitors who have previously attended. I have purchased some Messiah pens that I will be selling to raise

additional VBS funds.

The Easter Party is complete, and I have volunteers in place. Father Tom and I are playing messy games in April, and I am currently trying to narrow down some of the gross things we will do for this OUTDOOR event. SHINE has been learning different fun facts about the Episcopal Church, and why we do some of the things we do. Mother Tracy taught on communion, and we had a chance to touch all the holy hardware. We spent a Sunday talking about prayer and praying in the chapel as well as learning the Lord's Prayer.

Children's Church moved on from "What does the Bible" say to "Awesome Easter" lessons. Our kids drew wonderful pictures of Jesus praying in the garden of Gethsemane, and they are on the Narthex windows. We have a special craft on Palm Sunday and Maundy Thursday as well as goodie bags for all visiting children on Easter. We also have give-away Bibles for upper elementary age visitors.

**Youth Ministry:** Youth Minister Janie Walton reports: Activate members, Mackenzie Teolis and Chelsea Wilkinson-Borno, helped paint the exterior of a parishioner's house with other Messiah folks, on February 19.

We also attended a showing of Marvel's newest superhero movie, *Black Panther*, at West Orange Cinemas following the Absalom Jones Celebration. Activate members attended the Orlando Magic Faith and Family Night on March 2.

Our Activate middle school students attended New Beginnings Retreat at Camp Wingmann March 9-11.

We have a Jamaica Mission Trip Fundraiser planned for Saturday, March 17—Shamrockin' at the Movies with Activate.

We are providing dinner for Wednesdays IN Lent on March 21.

There will be no Activate on Easter Sunday, April 1.

Our Plant Sale Mission Trip Fundraiser at Spring Fever in the Garden is April 7-8 in downtown Winter Garden. There will also be no Activate meeting Sunday, April 8.

**Messiah Academy:** Their financial software is still not cooperating. They hope to have it fixed and a financial report for us soon.

**Assistant Rector Tracy Dugger reports:**  
Social Media and Website: Our website subcommittee held its first meeting March 8th. We reviewed 4 firms and agreed to go ahead with Worship Times. I compiled a list of the must haves and wants from staff and ministry leaders for our website. We then consolidated these into 25 desired features and ranked in order of importance. I obtained a signed contract with worship times on Friday March 9th. Our Social Media continues to have good traffic and we have gained several likes to our Facebook page. I will be running an ad for Palm Sunday through Easter on FB.

**Young Adult Ministry:** Trivia Tuesday was well attended in February with several new attendees. April 14th, the Borsts are hosting a YA BBQ gathering. 24/6 A study in Sabbath is wrapping up. Those who've attended have grown in time management and rest-

**Greg Chandler:** Tom Rutherford met with Greg on February 8 to see if Greg wanted to reengage in the discernment process toward priesthood. Greg asked for time to think and pray. Tom gave him a deadline of March 15 to make a decision. Greg contacted Tom on the 15<sup>th</sup> saying he needed more time. Tom has, therefore, ended Greg's discernment process, with the offer for Greg to start over if he so chooses.

**Pictorial Directory:** Vita Mazzaluna is leading the Team for a new pictorial directory. LifeTouch will take our pictures the week of June 18-23. Each parish family will get a complimentary 8X10 portrait and copy of the pictorial directory. They may also buy more pictures, if they want to. More details are coming soon, as we start publicity on Easter Sunday, so as to appeal to our "extra" folks who will be here that day and at Pre-school Sunday the next week.

**DISCUSSION (to help make a decision next month):** **Parish Security:** The Vestry discussed the security of our Church and concluded that what we are doing now is enough. The new website will have the capability for improving safety and security of our children and preschool students with a tighter check-in and check-out process.

### **DECISIONS (based on the Discussion last month):**

**The 2017 Parochial Report:**  
APPROVED with celebration of the following:

Only 3% of Episcopal congregations have an Average Sunday Attendance over 300. We are one of them!  
Few Episcopal congregations have as many children and youth as we do. 21% of our members are under age 16. Across denominations, in the healthiest congregations, 10% of

their members are elementary aged and younger, and another 10% are teenagers, so we're right in line! We're a 1.5-million-dollar operation! And ended the year with Total All Revenues exceeding Total All Expenses by \$328,616. Thank you, Jesus! Thank you, Britt family.

**New Missionary Outreach Community:** The Rev. Dr. Jon Davis, who planted the Church of the Incarnation and is resigning soon as Executive Director of Canterbury Retreat & Conference Center in Oviedo, is launching a new work in east Seminole County, specifically targeting "Nones" (people whose religious preference is "None") and "Dones" (people who have left the Church after being burned or disappointed by church people). Canons require approval from the Vestries of every congregation in the deanery before such a launch, and our vestry APPROVED this resolution: We, the Vestry of the Church of the Messiah, enthusiastically approve the formation of a new missional work in East Seminole County led by the Rev. Dr. Jon Davis. Jesus said, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few," so we pray for the LORD of the Harvest to send laborers into his field; to pour out the Holy Spirit and grant vision and energy for to how, when, and where to launch this work; to direct Jon and the other leaders to the people He'd have them serve; and to provide every resource necessary for this work.

This month I finally got around to reading *Battlefield of the Mind* by Joyce Meyer. I say finally because I bought the book at least a year ago, and hesitated to start it because I thought (for some reason) that it was political, and I felt I'd reviewed an adequate number of political books. But I discovered that it has zero to do with politics!

The theme of the book is that the problems we have, be it anger, frustration, stubbornness, unforgiveness, a wandering mind (my own biggest nemesis), or any other negative emotion, the problem is rooted in the mind, and must be dealt with on that basis.

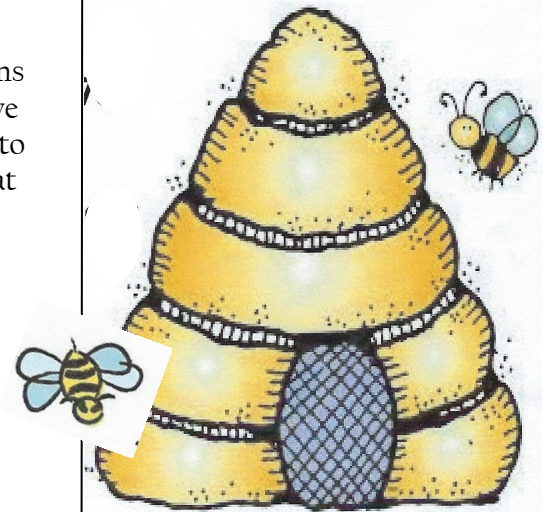
Satan loves to feed these negative emotions with rationalization and defensiveness, for example; but the only true defense is confession and submission to the power of the Holy Spirit.

Mrs. Meyer also explores the various types of "wilderness mentality" which kept the Israelites wandering in the desert for forty years, and explains the antidote to these attitudes. I think the main point is this: do not assume that you are simply a certain way, and nothing can be done. We can do all things

through Christ, who strengthens us. We must substitute positive attitudes for our negative ones to find the joyful life of victory that Jesus wants us to have.

During Lent I was also introduced to *The Marriage You've Always Wanted* by Gary Chapman, familiar to those who attended the Wednesday night group study. Now all I know are the videos that were played and the workbooks we used, but I thought they were right on the money. In many ways the same themes were addressed in *Battlefield of the Mind*: surprise, surprise! I'm sure Mother Tracy still has copies of the workbook if you are interested in buying one for \$10.00.

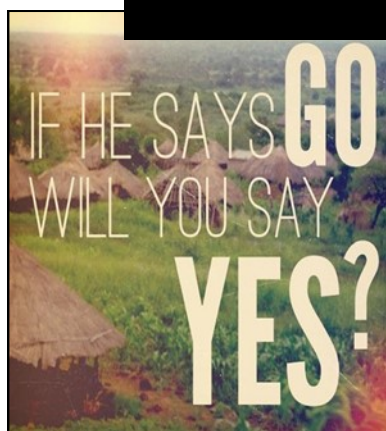

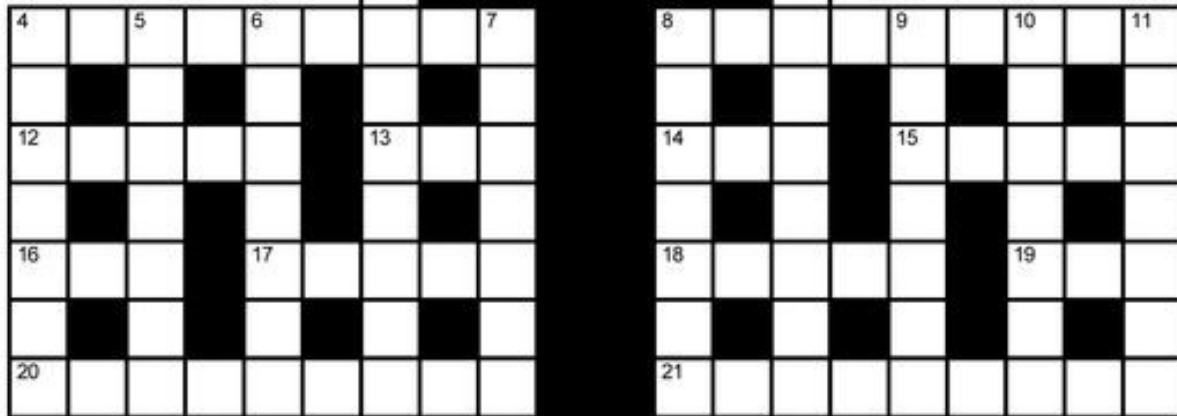
