Chewing on Our Daily Bread

Questions for conversation in your family, a Home Group, or with a friend

- 1. When Jesus first met the disciples on the road to Emmaus, they didn't recognize him. Tell about a time in your life when God was with you, but you didn't recognize he was there until later.
- 2. As Jesus taught the disciples from the Bible about the Messiah, the disciples' "hearts burned within them." Tell about a sermon, talk, lesson, or book that gave you a new insight about God, and how you felt when that happened.
- 3. The disciples recognized Jesus as he broke the bread with them. What is a way you recognized God was with you recently?
- 4. Jesus appeared again and "opened the scriptures" to his followers. What are some things that "open the scriptures" to you and help you understand them?

5. PRAY:

- → Thanking God for being with you, even when you didn't recognize it at the time.
- → For mind to understand and heart to obey the Bible.
