## Chewing on Our Daily Bread

Questions for conversation in your family, a Home Group, or with a friend

1. When Jesus first met the disciples on the road to Emmaus, they didn't recognize him. Tell about a time in your life when God was with you, but you didn't recognize he was there until later.
2. As Jesus taught the disciples from the Bible about the Messiah, the disciples' "hearts burned within them." Tell about a sermon, talk, lesson, or book that gave you a new insight about God, and how you felt when that happened.
3. The disciples recognized Jesus as he broke the bread with them. What is a way you recognized God was with you recently?
4. Jesus appeared again and "opened the scriptures" to his followers. What are some things that "open the scriptures" to you and help you understand them?
5. PRAY:
  - ✦ Thanking God for being with you, even when you didn't recognize it at the time.
  - ✦ For mind to understand and heart to obey the Bible.
  - ✦ For any needs in your group.
