III. Levitical Sacrifices

TYPE	WHERE	PURPOSE
Burnt Offering	<u>Leviticus 1; 6:8-13</u>	Daily morning and evening, atones for ongoing daily sin
Grain Offering	Leviticus 2	Always part of other offerings, never alone
Fellowship/ Friendship/ Freewill Offering	<u>Leviticus 3; 7:11-18</u>	Out of joy, gratitude, or result of a vow. Eaten by offerer.
Sin Offering	<u>Leviticus 4:1-5:13</u>	Penalty for unintentional sin of priests, leaders, whole community, or individual; or uncleanness (touching a carcass or filth)
Guilt Offering	Leviticus 5:14-6:7	For violations of religious law or failure to worship properly or to bring the correct type or amount of offering, or restitution for hurting someone else.

Other offerings for various cleansings: Leprosy & mildew (Leviticus 13-15).

Childbirth (<u>Leviticus 12</u>) 33 days for a boy and 66 days for a girl. Offering = lamb and a dove. But if can't afford a lamb, 2 doves.

Luke 2:21-24 Joseph and Mary go to the temple at 33 days and make offering:

Day of Atonement – Leviticus 16 – Once a year.

Scapegoat sent into desert.
