 - B. Psalms 78:1-2 – “I will open my mouth in parables.”
 - C. Zechariah 9:9-10 – “King comes riding on a donkey.”
 - D. Zechariah 11:12-13 – “30 pieces of silver thrown to the potter in the temple.”
 - E. Isaiah 52:13-53:12 – Suffering servant.
 - F. Psalms 22:1, 7-8, 12-18, 31 – Quoted on the cross. “It is finished.”
 - G. Zechariah 12:10 – “They will look upon the one they have pierced.”
 - H. Psalms 34:20 – “Not a bone of his shall be broken.”
 - I. Psalms 31:5 – “Into your hands I commit my spirit.”

J. Psalm 16:8-11 – “You will not let your Holy One decay.”
