#### 2021 December Vestry Minutes Thursday \* December 16, 2021, \* 6 pm

I. <u>FORMATION</u>: Chris led Compline. Based on Luke 2:8-12, Tom Rutherford invited us to share the gift we're most excited about GIVING this Christmas.

#### II. **INFORMATION:**

#### A. Vestry Ministry Team Reports:

- 1. Outreach Team: Doreen Stachowski reports:
  - a) Thank you to all volunteers who helped with the Christmas party at the Edgewood Children's Ranch on Saturday, December 4th. The Administrator said the children had a great time, the party was organized, and the activities were fun for all. The Outreach team is looking forward to planning more activities for them in 2022.
  - b) The next Outreach meeting will be scheduled after the Vestry retreat in early February. If you signed up during Messiah's Way, you will be included in the email. If you would like to be a part of the Outreach Team, and did not sign up, and want to serve God through this ministry, please contact Doreen Stachowski at stach45t@aol.com.
  - 2. No others recieved.

#### C. Staff Reports:

- 1. Children of the Messiah Preschool: The Financial Report was emailed separately.
- 2. Children's Minister Angela Lopez reports:
  - a) Advent is in full swing in the Children's Ministry! We are making an Advent candle each week and talking about the themes of hope, peace, love and joy. When we have finished the children will have a DIY Advent wreath with scripture on each candle. We have been learning a verse a week and the children are receiving squishy fidget toys as a prize. Our peace lesson led us to a discussion on bullying. Unfortunately, several of our kids are experiencing this at school. I will explore some resources and see what I can put together for a lesson series in the near future.
  - b) We have been working very hard on the Christmas play and it is looking pretty good. We are having a dress rehearsal with the band on December 19. Ms. Alice DeRosa has volunteered to help me with the stage direction, that is a huge blessing!
  - c) The SHINE kids are having a "shop for mom and dad night" where they will spend their Messiah Money on gifts for their parents. I received a box full of lovely Christmas ornaments and Knick Knacks that I am setting up for the kids to browse through. We will also be working on an oil pastel art project to give to parents.
  - d) I coordinated with the Outreach Team to host a wonderful Christmas party for Edgewood Children's Ranch. One of my Children's Ministry supporters covered the cost of the 200 slices of pizza--thank you!!! We gifted each child there with a sports bottle and bag of Christmas candy as well a board game and set of art supplies for each house. Our youth and adult volunteers had a wonderful time and report from the Ranch is that they had a blast and appreciated our not only being there but being very organized! Well done Messiah Crew! Thank you all for making this a beautiful night for everyone!
  - e) I will be dropping off toys and treats to Dillard Street Elementary next week. Thank you to everyone who donated toys or money. They had 60 children in need and we were able to bless 23 of them with a sack full of toys each! I will also be dropping off some of the Christmas meal gift cards.
  - f) Several events are on the horizon, stay tuned for cool pictures!

3. Facilities Minister Jeremy Adams reports: The year is wrapping up nicely for our rentals. We have had a total of 21 contracts signed this year by 12 different clients and have more in the works for 2022. Our gross annual rental income for 2021 officially passed \$20,000, surpassing our goal of \$15,000 by a third! Thank you to everyone for helping to spread the word about our beautiful facilities and for your patience as we hosted a variety of renters throughout the year. Currently, we have \$6,177.50 in signed rental contracts for 2022 and have a few leads in the works about more rentals. If you have any ideas to help spread the word about our rentals please let me know.

#### 4. Messiah School for the Arts' Co-Director Garine Adams reports:

- a) Our recent winter recital was well received, and it is available to watch online through the links on the church's Facebook and YouTube pages as well as Messiah School for the Arts' Facebook page. We are continuing to fill up our lesson schedules, so thank you all for the prayers! We are in talks with a new dance instructor to start setting up classes in the coming year.
- b) Drama club for middle/high school students meets weekly Thursdays from 3-5pm in the Parish Hall. They've begun preparing for a Spring performance. Our popcorn fundraiser is still running, and we were able to make some money from the Papa John's fundraiser that just ended.
- c) Preschool music and movement with Becky Sego from 10-11am on Friday mornings is going great! Lots of laughter and giggles.
- d) Messiah Youth Band is playing music for our Children's Christmas service this year as well as playing some tunes at Brookdale assisted living community in Wekiwa Springs during Christmas week. The band ended our winter recital with a great song of praise called The Blessing by Elevation Worship. It was a joy to sing and play along with them.

#### 5. **Office Minister** Julie Altenbach reports she and/or the Office Angels:

- a) Made envelopes for Christmas Poinsettias
- b) Organized and ordered Men's Supper and Ladies' Dinner
- c) Prepared West Orange Ministerial Association Luncheon for December
- d) Worked with Tech Minister Vita Mazzaluna to present the Tech class for our parishioners
- e) Prepared the candles and bulletins for Light Up Winter Garden
- f) Created and mailed Christmas cards from the Clergy and Staff
- g) Will be preparing the bulletins and inserts about our different ministries (ie. Shine, Activate, etc.) to put in Christmas Bulletins
- h) Prepared bulletin insert for Christmas Poinsettias
- i) Assisted with Edgewood Children's Ranch Christmas Party with Activate Youth and the Outreach Team

#### 6. Tech Minister Vita Mazzaluna reports:

- a) Office Minister Julie Altenbach and I co-led a class on Internet and Technology safety on Wednesday, December 8th. The topics included: identifying and avoiding scams both through email, phone, and text; password safety; safe online shopping and banking; as well as general internet/technology guidance. There were 3 people in attendance. We plan to do additional classes, hopefully once per month, and the next class topic requested by the participants was "Safe Online Shopping & Banking." We do not have a date for the January class yet but will definitely offer one! (Thank you again, Regina Seguin, for directing us to the base curriculum!).
- b) YAHOO! Jeremy received a Black Friday offer from the streaming service we use (Castr.io) so that I was able to get another account that allows 2 profiles. This is going to be WONDERFUL now that we can livestream from the Parish Hall AND...

- c) We also are now able to Livestream Diving Deeper! When we first started all the Livestreaming in 2020, Facebook did not allow more than one stream from a page at a time. That has changed! Between that change and the additional Castr.io profiles, we now do not have a conflict with streaming the 4 pm service and Diving Deeper. This will greatly reduce the steps needed to get Diving Deeper posted online AND will allow for questions from people watching from home. Sunday 12/12/21 will be the Pilot livestream!
- d) The Messiah School for the Arts Winter Concert was livestreamed using the USB camera setup. It was VERY nice to have preset camera angles to use!
- e) We will be livestreaming and recording many of the Christmas services. It feels SO nice to have the tech in place to do it!
- f) I am continuing to train new tech volunteers so that we have substitutes and can keep people from having to serve more often than they are comfortable though, so far, all of my volunteers seem to still enjoy it!

#### 7. Volunteer Youth Minister Garine Adams reports:

- a) The youth group has been volunteering more this season. We handed out candles for Light Up Winter Garden as well as helped provide a Christmas party at the Edgewood Children's Ranch. The youth seem fired up about going out and helping the community.
- b) We've been preparing for Christmas this Advent season by finishing our Book of Mark study in the Life Book to get a full picture of Jesus before his coming to this earth.
- c) We're planning to be a part of the Diocesan Soul in the City mission week in Deland in late July 2022 as well as planning our own local mission week earlier that month. Please pray and then contact Garine Adams if you'd like to help volunteer or fund the upcoming trips. It would be great to have two more committed adults to help drive and minister to the youth those weeks.
- **B.** Apprentice Rector: There is nothing new to report and probably won't be until next spring, when seminarians are in their last semester.
- **C. Vestry Nominations:** folks who have agreed to be nominees are: Mildred Dubic and Mary Kay Predmore. The retiring Vestry members will contact their potential candidates.
- III. <u>DISCUSSION</u> (to help make a decision next month): West Tree Service gave us a bid of \$5,800 to trim our oak and cypress trees and remove the Spanish Moss. Sarah Wolfe suggests we add this to 2022's budget. Wally Stewart recruited volunteers to trim the trees, but not remove the Spanish Moss, as horticulturalist and Junior Warden Chris Brown assured us the moss doesn't hurt the trees. Wally and Lay Weeder Captain John Peacock will assemble a team and rent a lift and have at it.

#### IV. **DECISIONS** (usually based on the Discussion last month):

- A. **2022 Budget** was emailed to vestry members with the Financial Report. It was APPROVED, with the addition of bumping Tech Minister Vita Mazzaluna's job from 10 to 12 hours per week, since that ministry has grown.
- B. Housing Allowance Resolutions for our clergy: The Internal Revenue Service allows clergy to receive a housing allowance as non-taxable income. The clergy tell us how much of their compensation should be allocated to Housing Allowance, and the Vestry formalizes that in resolutions in December. The Housing Allowance is revenue neutral for the parish: it doesn't affect the total amount paid to the clergy person; it just divides that amount into the two categories. Father Soner Alexandre doesn't need one of these, because we provide a house for him, which the IRS doesn't count as taxable income.
- C. Vestry APPROVED those resolutions.

#### V. <u>MEETING MINUTES & FINANCIAL REPORT:</u>

Minutes from the last month's meeting: APPROVED.

Last month's Financial Report from Treasurer Bob Tate: APPROVED.

Operating Income last month was \$6,821.22 LESS than Expenses, INCREASING our year-to-date DEFI-CIT to \$29,652.15.

Building Fund net income last month was \$1,164.58 LESS than our \$11,996.01 monthly mortgage and other expenses, INCREASING our year-to-date DEFICIT to \$6,267.66.

The vestry meeting closed with prayer and adjourned at 7:00 p.m.



This month I read two marvelous books: the one the Book Club read, which is <u>Redeeming Love</u> by Francine Rivers, and <u>Where Do We Go From Here?</u> by Dr. David Jeremiah.

I must confess I enjoyed <u>Redeeming Love</u> more, probably because it is a riveting story, but even more because it showcases "the Gospel in shoe leather," as Vernon Maghee used to say. It's about a young girl who, through no fault of her own, gets trapped into a life of prostitution. Believing (like her biological father) that she should never have been born, she viewed herself as a piece of human trash unworthy of love or respect. Was it God's love, Michael's love, or the love of all these other friends that led to Sara's (aka "Angel") finding redeeming love? Yes. Ultimately, of course, it was God's love; BUT the love of the others WAS God loving her. It's a fantastic story. And I recommend that you read the author's note in the back first, which explains how it came to be written.

The other book, by Dr. David Jeremiah <u>Where Do We Go From Here?</u> is also wonderful. Dr. Jeremiah addresses the issues of the day in the light of prophecy, and offers hope in the middle of the chaos. He reminds me of Bishop Howe at a diocesan convention many years ago. Someone asked him what hope we have, and he answered, "The same hope we've always had—the Lord Jesus Christ." I think you'll find it a thrilling book, as well.
