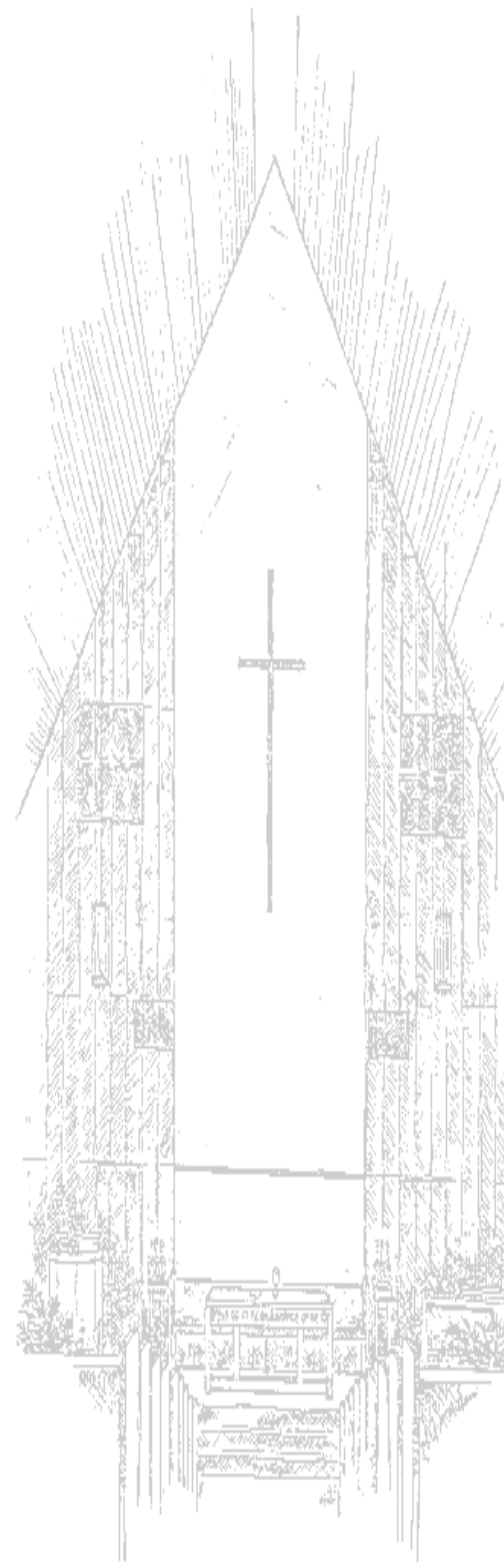
#### \*Call to Confession

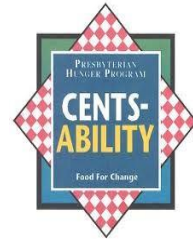
