Forgive us for breaking covenant with you, for we have not loved you with our whole heart and mind and strength. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.

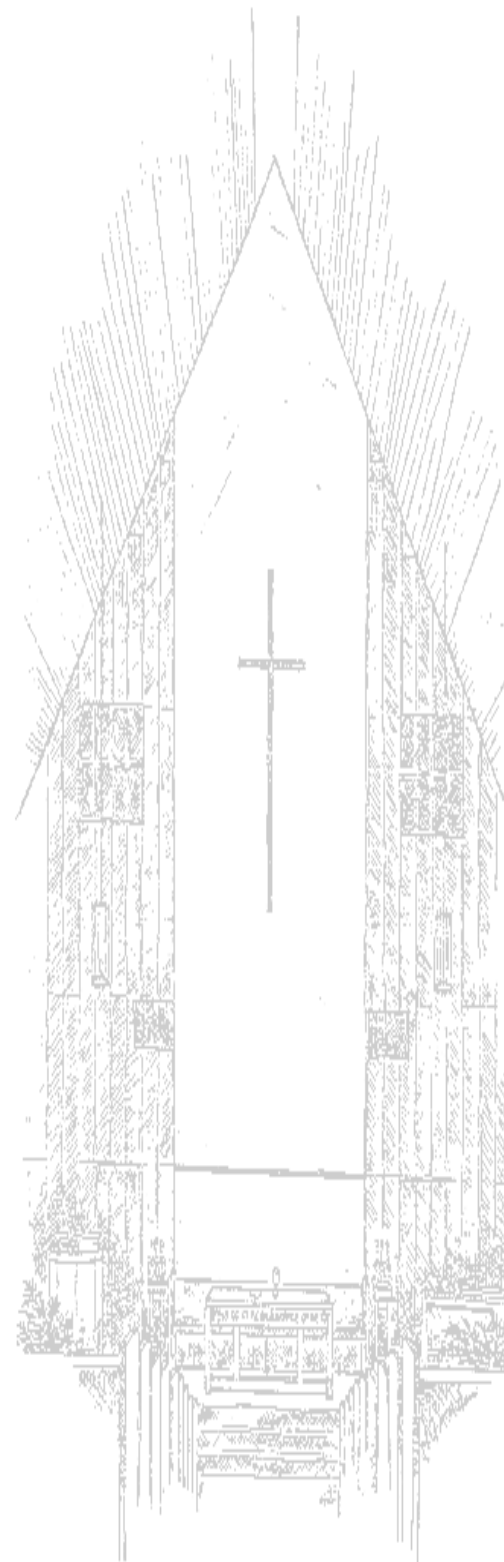
**We have not done justice, loved kindness, or walked humbly with you, our God.**
