Worship During the COVID-19 Pandemic: While the COVID-19 virus continues to pose some health risks to our community and congregation, we are committed to loving our neighbor by following the *Plan for Resuming In-Person Worship*, adopted by the Session on May 19, 2020. Thank you for your cooperation, flexibility and patience as worship in ways that may seem new or even strange to us. The *Plan* is reviewed regularly and new or updated provisions will be shared as soon as possible. Safety considerations include:

- Asking anyone who has COVID-19 symptoms, tested positive, or has been in close contact with someone who is sick in the last 14 days to worship from home;
- Use masks and good hand hygiene whenever in the building;
- Maintaining safe social distance from non-household members;
- Refraining from high-risk activities such as congregational singing and responses;
- Limiting surface transmission by removing items in the pews, keeping doors open, not passing items;
- Close attention to sanitizing surfaces;
- Keeping an accurate attendance record to facilitate pastoral care and contact tracing, if necessary.

We will continue to provide online worship access for the foreseeable future to include anyone who is unable or does not feel comfortable being physically present in worship.
