- Unless other arrangements are made with a parent or guardian, each student is expected to stay the entire night.
- All lock-in participants must respect others' physical boundaries.
- It is expected that all participants (youth and adults) will participate in the program.
- The first infraction will result in a verbal warning. Repeated violations will result in calling the parent to pick the youth up.
