

#### Dear Friends in Christ,

It has been a busy summer, but there has been so much good happening in and through this place!! We have been sharing the good news of Jesus and sharing God's love in all kinds of ways. In worship, we have experienced God's love for us and heard Jesus' call to us to live our lives as disciples, sharing God's love with the world. We have gone out in the world to show compassion to those who are in need, even



when we are not the people they most expect or desire compassion from. We have been learning about how others live and about how God's power lives so that we can live with courage, boldness, kindness, thankfulness and hope, all of which are needed in these days and times.

Our "Vector Verse" or the theme verse for our "To Mars and Beyond" VBS was "Glory to God who is able to do far beyond all that we could ask or imagine by his power at work within us" (Ephesians 3:20). It hit me this week that that verse sums up this summer. God's power at work within us has allowed us all to do more than we can ask or imagine in all of the ways that we have shared God's love in the world.

We are currently making about 400 lunches per week for the North Scott Community Feed Our Children Ministry, and we have just added back a site that we closed last year. We have had amazing volunteers from families to sports teams to community organizations to our faithful every day volunteers who have made this possible and helped us to continue to expand. The smiles on children's faces, the "thank you"s that we receive, the joy of getting to know others in our community as we work to put lunches together each week reminds me that God's power makes this possible, and while we hoped, in the beginning, that this ministry would be successful, God has taken it beyond what any of us would have imagined when we started!!

On the mission trip to South Dakota, our kids found out just what God's power can do. From overcoming fears in the beginning, being in a new place, among new people, in a culture we did not yet understand to doing all kinds of jobs to tear off and replace a roof, make signs and create a cement floor for a storage shed, we all learned that God gives us the power and the gifts to do things we never thought we would do. I can tell you that there were some in our group who never imagined that they would be standing on the top of a roof of a bunk house using drills and nail guns to weatherproof a roof so that youth in that community could have a warm and safe place to worship God during the winter. Others never imagined using a circular saw to cut wood down to the right lengths to make signs for the Chanku Waste Ranch. I definitely never imagined that I would learn how to mix and lay cement and actually get it mostly level so that the camp would have a safe place to store water and other supplies. And I am not sure any of us knew how amazing it would feel to show God's love to the community of Sharp's Corners as we put mulch on the playground, did  $\gamma$

I hope that you are all following all of the busyness around here on Facebook, and that you are taking advantage of the opportunities to hear about these and other ministries where God's power is moving in and through us to do more than we could ask or imagine. I pray that as we head back into the school year, these experiences of the summer will go with us and, inspired by the God who gave it all for us in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus, we continue to use God's power in us to make a difference right where we are so that we can change the world together.


